Subject: Expanded approach to the Royal Rangers Ministry "RR Lite"

Objective: To address some issues and provide possible resolve that has been already piloted and working.

Identified issues: These may or may not be USA wide, however are very much so in many areas.

- Royal Rangers has been in decline in both chartered outpost and non chartered outpost.
 Review your ACMR for the past 12 years to present in the AG churches.
- RR has been a discipleship driven ministry which is a positive, but also over the past 15-20 years finding leaders that are willing to prepare weekly, prior to the class, for the existing Program. Because of this many are not following the existing 11 point meeting plan which is driven to be a "Advancement" type of program (earning awards and having an advancement). While this is working for some of the outposts, many churches have dropped RR due to the needing DEDICATED leaders to prepare, take training to become successful.
- This is a cultural change that's been happening within our churches over the past two decades, some churches more than others.

Positive feedback: These are some of the positive feedback.

- We still need a boys program that ministers to boys and that has a tremendous impact of mentoring boys for Christ.
- Royal Rangers has a lot of great materials, with a few minor options we could offer a "Activity and or Merit Awards Driven" as an option to the current "Advancement Driven" system.
- Royal Rangers has materials already developed with teaching outlines for over 300+ merits for the Discovery, Adventure, Expedition Rangers and Achievement Awards for Rangers kids.
- By allowing a side by side option of Royal Rangers program ie "ROYAL RANGERS LITE" without the required use of the existing advancement program, churches would have the ability to pick and choose variety of methods to mentor boys with a minimum of basic suggested outlines.

- Have a Five Point meeting outline (90 minute)
 - 1) Opening ceremony
 2) Short bible study thought
 3) Main Feature
 4) Games
 5) Devotion
 10 minutes
 30 minutes
 25 minutes
 15 minutes

Five point meeting outline detailed:

Opening Ceremony

- o Pledges to the American & Christian Flag
- o Royal Rangers pledge code
- Introduce new boys/leaders

Ranger Kids – The RK Handbook for leader and parents to allow parents and boys to become familiar.

- o 1) Opening as shown
- o 2) Short bible study Available in existing program.
- 3) RK Achievement awards Leaders choice no specific order great learning and hands on with the kids
- o 4) Games -
- o 5) All groups come together for the closing devotional

Discovery, Adventure and Expedition

Recommend we develop a electronic outline(s) that would be available upon request to show the materials that are already available through national RR / My healthy Church to support the following:

- Opening as shown
- o 2) Bible study available from national Royal Rangers
- O 3) This is the area where the church would have a to choose, "LITE" is not driven by existing advancement structure. The options are, but not limited to:
 - Working on any of the 300+ merits as stand along. Existing merits have instructor outlines, teaching materials available through national RR.
 - Be hands on as little as possible in classroom and can include the time of (4)
 Game time when outside doing things they enjoy.
 - Merits for camping, cooking, archery, air rifle, computers, auto repair are just a few we have done with excellent response for the boys.
 - We plan a Father-Son Campout each year; We do this with other churches to have sufficient event leaders. This is an excellent event to have dads involved and have other men available to be available for adopt a son for the weekend.
 - RR LITE Rangers could attend district camps and events such as: Pinewood Derby; PowWow, Archery, Air Rifle are just a few that we attend and practice at outpost, and teach and prepare boys for these events prior to attending.

Conclusion:

These changes will allow young leaders, who themselves are not wanting, to teach advancement system, but like working with boys with adventure, activities and merits that they and the boys like.

This is a Win-Win!

- Royal Rangers and existing RR system can and should continue where the church and sufficient leadership wants to continue, no change.
- RR Lite would be built around activities, events and merits. The merits would transfer if the RR Lite program wanted to start working on the advancements.
- RR and RR Lite should charter with national office to receive discount for materials.
- RR Lite would have access to RR materials.
- · Royal Rangers would have access to District Events, ie PowWow, Training, Pinewood Derby etc.
- Recommend hosing Father-Son Campouts and or a Father-Son Day events this can be done as a church or several churches joining together and or sponsored by RR District.
- RR Lite clothing would have RR or RR Lite T-shirts blue jeans and optional ball cap.

Marketing will be key!

- Will develop outlines for RR Lite as examples and have available on electronic format.
- NCN RR will provide a workshop class at our April 4th District Commanders Conference & Awards Banquet.

Ranger Derby Spec's

Date - January 3, 2020

Race Car Specifications

- All Cars for both race and workmanship must roll down the track without interfering with any other car. All cars shall not exceed the following:
 - a. A car cannot exceed 7-1/2" in length.
 - b. A car cannot exceed 2-3/4" in width.
 - c. A car cannot exceed 3" in height.
 - d. A car cannot exceed 6 ounces (170 grams) in weight.
 - e. A car must have a minimum of 3/8" clearance from the bottom of the tires to the lowest part of the car body, whether it be the wood block, weights, decorations, etc. (Weights must be an integral part of the car, Weights can not be taped or set on a car. If weights or any part of a car comes off, there is no contest. The heat will be re-run, if the same car or parts leave the track again the car will be disqualified from racing. No heat or race will be held up while repairs are made.
 - f. <u>Super-Modified Class</u>: This is just what the name implies, a class where you can use all your ingenuity and imagination, however you must use the parts in the kit for their designed purpose. The class is open to anyone at our church level racing. The rules are:
 - (1) Wheels are to be used for proper intent and purposes and for the function for which they are intended. Super-Modified class cars shall be made from official Pinewood Derby kits.
 - (2) A car shall not be more than 6 inches tall and 3 inches wide.
 - (3) No car shall weigh more than 32 oz. (908 grams).
 - (4) No car shall exceed 12 inches in length.
 - (5) Metal to metal contact including any type of bearings or bushings is allowed in the Super-Modified Class.
 - (6) All other rules of the Ranger Derby apply.
- g. Open Class: This class is open to any family member, pastor(s), girls club and classes per outlined for the day.
- 2. Lubrication is permissible (any lubricant) but it is best not to use one that is petroleum based.

3. NO-NO'S:

- No bearing or bushings of any type or the car except in the super-modified class.
- No metal-to-metal contact on the car is allowed except in the super-modified class.
- c. No starting devices are allowed.
- d. No lubing or working on cars after they have been registered. Exceptions must be cleared by Ranger Derby Referee.
- 4. **Register and check- in** your car on race day. The car can be in both Race and Workmanship (Show), you may also have 2 cars one for race and another for workmanship in the same class, however both cars can not be in both race and workmanship.

5. Workmanship Outline:

- a. The judges will not converse while judging.
- Any comments will be in writing and will consist of the car number and score using the workmanship judging score sheet
- c. Score Sheets will be given to the officer in charge as soon as a judge has completed judging.
- d. There are generally 3 areas the car will be judged:
 - (1) Originality: The idea of the artist himself. You must take into account how much creative thought went into the design.
 - (2) Workmanship: The skill the workman shows in cutting, carving, sanding and detailing out the car. Consider: Are the cars extra ornaments made by the owner or something bought and attached?
 - (3) Color and Appearance: Use of color and outward appearance. Take into account the painting of the car. It's overall texture, the color and paint.
- e. Qualifications: Each contestant may enter one car in the class they enter. It does not have to be the same car if one is entered as race and the other as workmanship, but they must meet the same qualifications per the specifications outlines above #1.
- f. Each Ranger Derby Car being judged in the Workmanship Class, may have a 3"x5" card next to the car giving a brief description of the work completed by hand, parts used and parts store-bought








District Canoe Use Policies & Procedures


